 Johns this 12th May A.D. 1849 between Edward Walsh
 of St. Johns aforesaid Liherrman of the one part
 and Martin Murphy of same place Farmer of the
 other part. Witnesseth that in consideration of
 Ten pounds by he the said Edward Walsh hath
 granted bargained sold assigned and conveyed
 unto the said Martin Murphy his heirs and assigns
 and assigns All that piece or parcel of land
 situate on the South side of River Head and bounded
 as follows that is to say on the North by the Public
 Road and extending along the same four hundred
 and ninety feet and on the East by lands of one
 Thiburn and extending thereby from point to point
 two hundred and fifty feet on the West by the land
 of Thomas Shortall and on the South by the lands of one
 Selater and which said piece of land was
 originally the property of one John Walsh father of the
 said Edward Walsh who has been in possession of it by
 himself and his tenants for over twenty four years
 together with all ways to Johave and Johold the same
 unto the said Martin Murphy his heirs and assigns for
