Campbell Macpherson to the said Elyza St. Mary Adams. as aforesaid receipt whereof is acknowledged she hath granted bargained sold aliened and released unto the said Campbell Macpherson his heirs Adams & assigns All that piece of land on the West side of the Topsail Road and being near the seventh mile stone from St John bounded on the North and South sides by two roads each of one chain in width. on the East by the aforesaid Topsail Road and on the West by ungranted land which is more particularly described in a map drawn and annexed to a plan for the Govt. to one John O'Houagan to 495. dated November 30th 1846 To have and to hold the same unto the said Campbell Macpherson his heirs Adams & assigns forever. Saunders of same place I have of my own free will and full power receipt whereof I acknowledge have bargained sold assigned transferred and set over unto the said Saunders his heirs Adams and assigns All that piece of land situate at Cormiston near St. John's aforesaid and bounded on the East by land sold to Frank St. John and intending thereby two hundred feet on the North by a Reservation for a new line of street to be known as Fifth Avenue and intending thereby seventy five feet on the West by land sold to John Burns and intending thereby two hundred feet and on the South by a Reservation for a new line of street to be known as South Avenue and intending thereby seventy five feet
