deliver unto the said Elizabeth Forrestal all my right  
title and interest in and to a piece of Ground bounded  
by me from Alice Gorman situated on the North Side  
of Maryland in the County aforesaid bounded on the  
North East by ground belonging to Luke Brown  
on the South West by a path leading to the Court  
House on the South East of the main town on the  
North West by Ground belonging to Luke Brown and  
Nehemiah Gorman to have and to hold the said  
bargained and sold property unto the said Elizabeth  
Forrestal her Executors Administrators and assigns  
for ever and the said John White for himself his  
Executors Administrators and assigns the said hereby  
bargained property unto the said Elizabeth Forrestal  
her Executors Administrators and assigns against  
all persons shall and will warrant and forever  
defend by these presents

 Patrick Fitzgerald of St Mary's in the County  
 of our said Sovereign of the one Part and William  
 Burke of the same Place Part of the other Part  
 Witnesseth that the said John Dim & Fitzgerald  
 for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds  
 Sterling of good and lawful money of Great Britain  
 to be paid them by the said William Burke the
