## In the name of God amen

I Robert Hutchings of Saint Johns in the Island of Newfoundland. Boat keeper being of sound and disposing mind but weak in body. Do make ordain publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. First I Commit my soul to almighty God and my Body to Earth from whence it came and as for and concerning all my worldly Estate Goods and Chattles which it hath pleased God to blep me with Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my Nephew George Hutchings Junior (after the death of his Father) two Boats Rooms together with the House Store Stage and Cook Rooms now let to and occupied Mr Thomas Rowe also a proportionable part of the Gardens and meadows belonging to the said Room or plantation. Item I give unto my Brother Arthur Hutchings the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling to be paid to him in manner and form following. That is to say the value of Five pounds per annum in wearing apparel for ten years from the time of my decease and no longer all the rest of my Goods and Chattles whether

moneys in England or Plantations in Newbunland  
I give and bequeath unto my Brother George  
Hutchings to be disposed of in any manner he shall  
think proper. and I do hereby appoint and order  
the said George Hutchings to be my sole Executor  
of this my last Will and Testament. In-  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands  
and Seal. at Saint Johns aforesaid this seventh  
day of July in the twenty fifth year of the Reign  
of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace  
of God King Defender of the Faith &c and in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
eighty six -
